

Top performing Seagulls

Christchurch Seagulls swimming team were in action last weekend at the James Morino Open Meet at Southampton Quays Swimming Pool.

There were some great all round performances with 38 personal bests (pb's) being recorded.

Of particular note was Peter Griffiths who gained medals and pb's in all of his six races, while Isabelle Frampton also scored a full house with 8 pb's from eight races. Competing in her first Open meet, Sophie Duffell achieved second place in the 50m breaststroke and Connor Sleightholme managed a good pb on his 100m butterfly and picked up a silver medal as well.

Peter Griffiths and Isabelle Frampton's times indicate they should both now qualify for the South West Championships, Peter in the 200m freestyle and 200m individual medley and Isabelle for the 200m freestyle.

Seagulls' coach Barry Alldrick said: "I think that today's performances show both how the club is moving forward and great promise for the future. I'm proud of what all my swimmers achieved and want to congratulate them on all of their hard work which is now beginning to pay off".
